FINANCIAL AID/SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES 2023-2024

Bishop Amat High School offers several types of scholarship and financial assistance to students enrolled in our school.

- **Honors at Entrance Scholarships**

Honors at Entrance Scholarships are granted to incoming 9th grade students only. Students who score in the 95th to 99th national percentile on the Bishop Amat Entrance Exam will receive a scholarship in the amount of \$4,000, students who score in the 90th to 94th percentile will receive a scholarship in the amount of \$3,000, and students who score in the 85th to 89th percentile will receive a scholarship in the amount of \$2,000. These scholarships are awarded regardless of a families income.

- **Catholic Education Foundation Tuition Awards (TAP)**

The Catholic Education Foundation provides \$2,000 tuition awards to students whose household income meet their published income guidelines.

Applications for CEF Tuition Awards are available in the Bishop Amat High School Finance Office or online at www.bishopamat.org. On-campus interviews conducted by CEF personnel are scheduled to take place on December 12, 2022 and December 19, 2022. The on-campus interview is very important. Families will be informed at the interview if they qualify for an award and if any additional financial information is needed in order to process the application.

Families who are unable to schedule an on-campus interview must turn in their application and supporting documentation to the Bishop Amat Finance Office by January 3, 2023.

- **Bishop Amat Scholarship/Financial Aid Opportunities**

In order to be considered for a Named Scholarship, Foundation Scholarship, or Bishop Amat financial aid, a Bishop Amat High School Application for Financial Aid must be submitted. **All financial aid awarded is need-based.** The only merit scholarships are Honors at Entrance and Distinguished Scholar Awards (incoming 9th graders).

Applications for Bishop Amat Financial Aid are available in the Finance Office. The deadline to apply is February 10, 2023. Late applicants will be placed on a "Waitlist" and considered on a first come first serve basis. Required income verification: completed 2021 tax return, W2's for 2022, and a current paycheck stub.

Important Note: Applications for financial aid must be applied for each year. Families who meet the CEF Income Guidelines **must** apply for a CEF Tuition Award in order to be eligible to apply for Bishop Amat financial aid.
